Highlights from the November 6, 2001 Meeting

The meeting began at 7:10 pm at the Tise House. **Treasury:** Up to \$1000 has been obligated for legal fees in our appeal to the Zoning Board of Adjustment for conditions to be added to the YMCA certificate of appropriateness for the demolition of the first 3 houses on West End owned by the Y. The invoice has not yet been received. **Social Committee:** Alex Flowers reported that there have been requests for more welcome baskets for new West End apartment residents. This month's social will be Friday, November 9 from 6:00-8:00 pm at Marty and Alex Flowers' house on 638 Spring Street. The holiday party will be on December 8th at the Merschel's at 1211 Fourth Street. It will feature potluck side dishes and desserts. A Valentine's party is scheduled for February 16th at the Tise House and will likely also be a potluck. Linens will need to be purchased or rented. Tables are available. The group decided to have a D.J. and not to wear costumes. It was suggested that we invite the merchants, historic district committee, and planning staff. There will not be a social in January. **The WEA Board members:** Be thinking about nominations for new board members and officers whose terms will expire this year. Nominations will be needed prior to our January meeting that will be on the **second** Tuesday of the month (January 8) due to the New Year's holiday

Police Report: Theft of bicycles from a basement on Piedmont Avenue has been reported, as have several burglaries and vandalism in the area. Also there are men approaching people in the neighborhood asking for a ride, money to repair a car, cab fare, etc. Those who have attempted to give them a ride to their (supposedly) broken-down cars have found that there were no cars (Surprise!) **HDC:** Two members abstained from the vote regarding putting conditions on the certificate of appropriateness. Zoning Board of Adjustment seemed lost in the "legalese." They ruled in favor of the YMCA. They did not look at the second point, which was that there had been significant change since the initial application (the Freeman house was to remain when the first COA was granted). **South Central Area plan:** The initial meeting is next Wednesday, November 14th from 7-9 pm at YWCA. Eric Elliott and Amy Lindsay were voted to be our representatives. Come to the meeting and help brainstorm. A macro plan is being put together to include things like traffic plans, parks, zoning, etc.
